

# IMMUNIZATION REMINDER FOR

FROM THE NORTHERN NYE/ESMERALDA COUNTY COMMUNITY HEALTH NURSE

- **All** children enrolled and/or attending any child care facility, pre-school, public, or private schools must be immunized and received proper boosters.

Information and exemptions can be found @ NRS 432A.230, NRS 392.435, and NRS 394.192

- All students who will **enter 7<sup>th</sup> grade** this fall, are **required** to have additional immunizations. (Receiving the immunizations while in 6<sup>th</sup> grade, **will count** for the school entry requirement this fall.)

THE NORTHERN NYE/ESMERALDA COUMMUNITY HEALTH NURSE HAS VACCINE AT THIS TIME.

WE ARE CONTRACTED WITH MOST INSURANCES CARRIED BY FAMILIES IN THIS AREA. WE ALSO CAN ACCEPT MEDICAID/NEVADA CHECK UP AND HAVE A PROGRAM TO ASSIST THE UNINSURED FAMILIES.

“PRIVATE” VACCINE AVAILABILITY DEPENDS ON THE BUDGET, AND A SUPPLY OF THEM IS NOT PREDICTABLE. VACCINE IS AVAILABLE NOW, ON A FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED BASIS. IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT YOU TAKE ADVANTAGE OF THE OPPORTUNITY, AND NOT GET CAUGHT HAVING TO GO OUT OF TOWN AT THE LAST MINUTE BEFORE SCHOOL DUE TO VACCINE NOT BEING AVAILABLE LOCALLY.
